



SPECIAL REGULATION FOR LITERATURE CLASS

The exhibition of philatelic literature is with international participation, organized by the Cinisellese Philatelic Circle (federated FSFI).

It will take place from 12 to 13 October 2024. The is Villa Stampa, Piazza Soncino 5 Cinisello Balsamo

Participation condition

- 1.1** The participation of the exhibition is free of charge to send one copies
- 2.2** The philatelic literature class includes all printed communications relating to postage stamps, postal history, teaching, to their collections or any other specialized sector
- 2.3** Participations can be presented by the author, the curator, the publisher, organizations or companies, or any person who has the property rights.
- 3.0** The literature class is divided into the following classes;
- 3.1** Books, specialized catalogs, studies, bibliographic works, auction catalogs and other publications, especially philatelic research
- 3.2** General, world, national and sectoral catalogs whose extension does not qualify them as specialized.
- 3.3** Periodicals, journals, association bodies, yearbooks and such publication (send 2 years)
- 3.4** Websites (working with a system at least Windows XP, 10. Android 4.0
 - 4.1** The publication dates must not be earlier than 5 years prior to the year of the 2024 exhibition (1 January 2018)
 - 4.2** For multi-volume works, the publication date of the last volume is considered. New editions are considered new participations.
For periodicals, the vintage or the two most recent vintages participate.
- 4.3** Participations in non-European languages must have a comprehensive summary in one of the main languages English, French
- 5.1** Exhibitor must send two copies of each tide or volume, wich will not returned
 - 6.1** Applications must be completed by june 15, 2024 sent by

- 7.1** Participants must send the publication of the participation to the following address:

that arrivals by 1 September 2024
- 7.2** Exhibits send from outside the custom free European aerea be accompanieg by a pro forma invoice describing the item is a 'specimen' and declare 'not commercial value'
- 8.1** Jury and awards
Participation in Expo 2024 will be judged by a jury appointed by the Committee Organizer, in accordance with the special Regulations for the evaluation of philatelic literature participation in exhibitions, a digital diploma will be issued with a medal certificate and any prizes received from institutions.
- 9.1** The Organizing Committee will provide the jurors with the list of participation at least 30 days before the exhibition
- 10** After the exhibition all the participations will be donated to the local library or similar
